## You anoint my head with oil. . .

Philip Keller talks extensively in this chapter about the oil that is placed on the sheep to protect them from pest like flies and from diseases like the spreading of "scabs." He expresses how in our Christian life the Lord gives us the Holy Spirit which is the oil of anointing. The third person of the trinity, the Holy Spirit, is the One who was promised to the disciples right before Jesus crucifixion (John 16) and right before His ascension (Luke 24:44-49). He indwells all believers.

In scripture the meaning of the oil is not a difficult matter to understand. A quick word study through the Bible will suffice. The oil quite typically represents the anointing of the Holy Spirit. The scriptures tell of the oil of gladness and the oil of anointing of God's Presence. The Old Testament scriptures showcase the oil of anointing for priests and kings. Throughout the Bible we also see the oil for the lamps which brings the Light of God's illumination.

In the Parable of the Ten Virgins, Jesus shared about this same concept. Poetically the Word and Light of God is in this parable as "a lamp unto our feet" to help guide us along the pathway when the hours of darkness come. Read Matthew 25:1-13 and write below the correspondences you see between the oil of the lambs the virgins carried and what you know of from the Holy Spirit.
